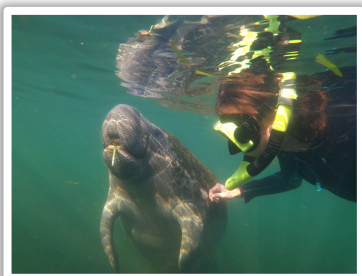

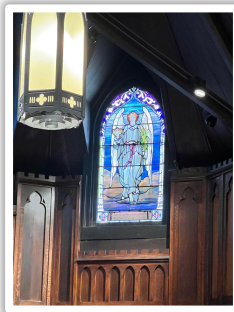

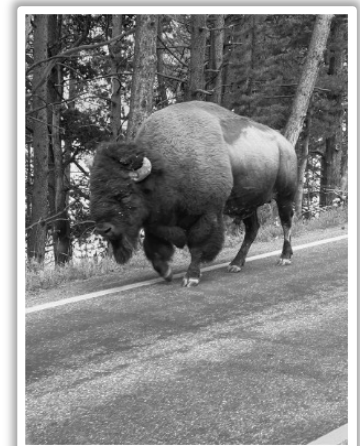

THE MAGNIFICENT MID-WEST TOUR August 12-28, 2025 (Tuesday-Thursday)

We are off to visit the “Old West” and our beautiful National Parks. This trip is what bucket lists are made of. It all starts when we travel to St. Louis for the night. We will be so close to the St. Louis Arch, that we will take a stroll through the museum before we go into those interesting elevators for our view from the top of the Arch. After we check out the Arch view we will travel back down and watch a great movie about how this amazing structure was formed and placed where it stands today. After all this, we rest as we travel toward our next destination. Each day finds us somewhere new, experiencing such unique places along the way, such as the Pony Express Museum in St. Joe, MO. Here we learn the story of the first mail system on horseback. While in town we visit the Pattee Museum. This is an incredible Museum! There is everything from a light bulb and camera exhibit to old cars and there are way too many unique exhibits to mention here. Jesse James’ house is connected to the Pattee Museum, hear the story of this outlaw and see some of the famous artifacts. He was shot by his friend as he adjusted a picture on the wall in this little house. Next it is on to the Corn Palace! For more than 100 years



this building has been full of corn art. It is redesigned each year. We take a tour and check out the many designs of years before. This is one big bird feeder! (We overnight in Mitchell, SD.) Traveling on, we come across The Dignity Statue. She is 50 ft. tall and makes for a nice place for a picnic lunch on our way to the Badlands National Park. Keep your eyes open for mountain goats, prairie dogs, and maybe even a bison or two as we cruise through the Badlands on our way to Wall Drug for supper (on your own). We will overnight in Rapid City, SD for the next two nights. Rapid City will find us climbing a mountain by bus to see Mount Rushmore and take an optional walk / hike around the Presidential trail for a more up-close view of the faces. You can see right up George Washington’s nose from within the inside of a rock. While in the area, we will explore the towns of Keystone; and Custer. There will be time to check out the story of the Crazy Horse Memorial and stop by the *Dancing With Wolves* movie set for a self-guided tour of the set and a chuckwagon style meal. Since we travel by Devils Tower we make a quick stop to get a better look. There are so many legends about how this interesting spot on this Earth came to be. After supper in the area we overnight in Gillette, WY. The next morning we will continue changing landscapes to Cody, WY. We call Cody, WY home for the next three nights. We will spend a few days exploring the area near and in Yellowstone National Park. One day will be exploring by bus and then another day we will be changing to vans for a private wildlife tour of part of the North loop. Be sure to look out for bear, bison, elk, coyote, big horn rams and eagles.

If we are lucky, we will get stuck in a bison traffic jam on our way to visit views like Artist Point, Old Faithful and Grand Prismatic. A couple of years ago two bison gave us a big show when they got into an argument over a female bison who walked by the front of our bus. The one bison knocked the other one about 3 feet back! (Due to Park animals and weather, sites are subject to change...)

We stay in Cody, Wy each night so if you choose to take in the Rodeo on your own then that is an option. We leave Yellowstone out the South Exit by Yellowstone Lake through the Grand Tetons on our way to Jackson Hole, WY. Next up is Cheyenne, WY for a stop at the Terry Bison Ranch for a ride on the homemade train (waiver required) to feed the herd of bison. Have you ever seen a bison tongue? They are long and kind of purple! After our Bison adventure we will have supper and overnight in Cheyenne. As we head for home we have a few more adventures along the way. Traveling from the mountains through a desert to Salina, KS. There is a stop at the Great Platte River Archway Museum for a self-guided tour and supper. This unique Museum spans above and across the highway as you learn about the land lottery and how the wagon trains settled the land. Have you ever heard of Pawhuska? You might have, if you watch *The Pioneer Woman* on TV. This is where the Ree Drummond stores are. We will have lunch in the area and then shop a while at the Mercantile and Bakery. This meal is wonderful and served in a private building just for us. There will be time to visit the Ben Johnson Cowboy Museum and shop. We will overnight in Oklahoma. We will visit The National Cowboy & Western Heritage Museum for a self-guided tour. Lunch is on your own at the Museum Café. Then we make a stop by the Oklahoma City National Memorial. Then it is on to Fort Smith, AR, for dinner and a play with Ms. Laura and her friends. We will have a guided tour of town before we
